Unexpected Wildlife Refuge began in 1961 as the home of Cavit and Hope Sawyer Buyukmihci who dedicated their land to habitat preservation so that the unique Pine Barrens native wildlife and habitat could thrive.

Today, we are a nonprofit, tax-exempt organization supported entirely by private donations. The Refuge continues to be an inviolate sanctuary for wildlife and we support the



promotion of humane education. The original 85 acres purchased by the Buyukmihcis have grown to 767 acres of swamps, bogs, forests, fields and lakes that stretch over Gloucester and Atlantic counties, providing an extensive habitat for animal and plant species indigenous to the southern New Jersey Pinelands region.

The Refuge has ten miles of walking trails which pass through wetlands habitat, fields, forests and past the Refuge's active beaver lodges.
